## What is Trilateral Youth Summit?

Trilateral Youth Summit is a student exchange program started under the initiative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea in 2014 and has been held annually since with the aim to deepen mutual understanding and foster friendships among undergraduate and graduate students of the three countries. Held on a rotational basis, this year's program will take place in Kansai, Japan.

Through a week long intensive program, participants will discuss four agendas where the role of the youth is critical in the future (People-to-People Exchange & Youth Education, Sustainable Development & Disaster Relief, Economic, Technology & Local Revitalization, and Health & Ageing Society) and conduct mock Trilateral Summit on the last day. Various site visits and cultural experience opportunities will also be offered.

## Eligibility

- Undergraduate or graduate student as of July 2025
- Fluent in English
- Chinese or Korean nationals
- Available for full participation: August 4–9, 2025
- Under age 30
- Has a strong interest in Trilateral Cooperation



## Main Program

### 1. Group discussion & Mock Trilateral Summit

- Discussion in 4 committees
  - People-to-People Exchange & Youth Education / Sustainable Development & Disaster Relief / Economic, Technology & Local Revitalization / Health & Ageing Society
- Discussion in 4 delegations (China; Japan; ROK; TCS)
- Mock Trilateral Summit
  - Designation to committee and delegation will be determined by the host based on participants' preferences.

### 2. Lectures

- Key areas of Trilateral Cooperation to be further strengthened following the outcomes of the recent Trilateral Summit
- Significance of Trilateral Cooperation and the role of youth
- Trilateral Summit process and mechanisms

### 3. Site Visits & Cultural Experiences

\*Visits to relevant institutes and cultural sites will be arranged.
